PURPOSE

The Community Services Committee of Local 2001 of the Communications Workers of America was established to support the continuing efforts by the Union to further the goal of providing assistance to its membership and the community which it serves.

In 1991, a time of economic uncertainty, the Community Services Committee recognized the need to provide financial assistance to those individuals motivated to enhance their formal education after High School.

On September 16, 1991, in the spirit of furthering the cause of the labor movement, the Community Services Committee moved to establish the Scholarship Fund to meet the needs of those individuals.

It is proper that this scholarship be established to benefit those individuals motivated to excel as citizens of the community and the society in which they serv

ELIGIBILITY

A five-hundred dollar scholarship available for use in any nationally accredited College, University or Trade School will be awarded annually by the CWA Local Scholarship Fund on the basis of a random drawing from among applicants who have met the application criteria. The check will be made out to the school the winner is planning to or is already attending.

Who is Eligible to Compete: All members, their children or legal wards of members in good standing of CWA Local 2001. Also the children or legal wards of disabled, retired or deceased members who were in good standing of Local 2001 at the time of retirement or death.

How to apply: Applicant must fill out the Application Blank, giving all required information. Incomplete information will be cause for rejection of the application. The applicant will be verified by an Officer of the Local as to whether the applicant, applicant's parent or applicant's guardian is a member of CWA Local 2001.

An Essay of no less than five hundred typed words on Labor History must be submitted **along with the application.**

Applications must be postmarked or received by **April 30th**. The application can be mailed or dropped by the Local Office at 2512 Kanawha Boulevard, East, Charleston, West Virginia 25311.

Application forms can be obtained by calling the Local Office at 304-344-2001.

A random drawing to select the winner of the scholarship will be held at the **May Membership Meeting.**
